



Propane Mower Incentive Program Guidelines

INCENTIVE AMOUNTS

The Propane Council of Texas (ProCOT) is offering incentives for newly purchased factory-direct propane commercial mowers or gasoline mowers converted to propane. ProCOT will pay **\$1,000** per mower.

The perpetual cap was increased in 2016. Applicants are now eligible for up to **\$7,000** in mower incentive awards per entity throughout the lifetime of the ProCOT program.

ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

- ✓ **Eligible entities include:** landscapers, parks departments, school districts, universities, businesses, and farmers in the state of Texas that use **at least 500 gallons of propane a year**.
- ✓ Qualifying mowers can now be **bi-fuel** or **dedicated**.
- ✓ Qualifying mowers must be commercial grade propane-powered walk behind, belt drive, or zero turn riders purchased or converted. Units must have **less 300 hours** prior to conversion.
- ✓ Mowers and conversion systems must be Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and/or California Air Resource Board (CARB) **certified** to use propane.
- ✓ Mowers purchased or converted must be operated in Texas.

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

1. **Participating Service Dealers** are licensed by the Railroad Commission of Texas to sell and service propane mowers. They will need a Category L license. For more information, please visit www.propane.tx.gov.
2. **Participating Service Dealers** are responsible for educating the Purchaser about the care, maintenance and operation of the mowers.
3. Installation of a **conversion** system must be performed participating service dealer and by a Railroad Commission certified technician on units with less than 300 hours of operation or by the end-user trained by the propane mower system manufacturer.
4. **Participating Service Dealers or Conversion Company** performing a conversion must provide a

Railroad Commission license number, which must be outlined on the propane mower application.

5. The **Purchaser's** fleet may be a landscaper, parks department, school district, university, business, or farmer that uses at least 500 gallons per year.
6. The **Purchaser** shall agree to follow the equipment manufacturer's recommendations for maintenance of propane engine and conversion equipment.
7. The **Purchaser** shall agree that the equipment for which an incentive is provided must remain in use, in the service area, for a minimum of three (3) years or until sold.
8. All rebate recipients will be required to submit a pre-incentive survey with application and must submit a post-incentive survey within one year from your incentive.
9. **Purchaser** shall agree that the information gathered within the surveys can be used by the propane industry for but not limited to the following: industry reports, articles, and case studies.
10. **Purchaser** must be in good-standing with the Propane Council of Texas (ProCOT). All past due post-incentive surveys on previous propane mowers in which purchaser received an incentive must be submitted to ProCOT to be eligible for additional incentives.

APPLICATIONS

Please submit the completed incentive application within 60 days of the mower purchase or conversion date. Pre-qualification forms can be downloaded by visiting www.procot.org or www.fuelingtexas.com. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Include a copy of the following:

- Completed application for each mower
- Computer-generated invoice for each mower
- Pre-Incentive Survey <http://initialstatemowers.questionpro.com/>
- Copy of the EPA/CARB certification
- Photo of the propane commercial mower being funded
- Entity receiving incentive's W-9
