



COMMERCIAL PROPANE MOWER INCENTIVE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The Propane Council of Texas is accepting applications for incentives on the purchase of new, dedicated, commercial, propane mowers and conversions of existing mowers to propane.

Q. Who is eligible for this program?

A. Landscapers, businesses, schools, universities, municipalities, county parks departments, and farmers operating in Texas that plan to use at 500 gallons of propane per commercial grade mower are eligible to apply. Individuals and state agencies are not eligible.

Q. Where can I find a propane commercial mower?

A. There are over 17 major mower manufacturers that produce over 135 factory-built propane mower models. You can go to any mower dealer carrying that brand and have them order one for you. An alternative option is for you to convert an existing commercial mower. Conversions can only be performed on mowers with less than 300 hours for our state program.

Q. Who converts the equipment?

A. All eligible propane mowers and engines must be Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and/or California Air Resource Board (CARB) certified. Both dedicated and dual-fuel are now eligible. Conversions can only be performed by LPG technicians certified by the Railroad Commission of Texas. **Pre-qualification is highly encouraged.**

Q. How do I participate in the Propane Council of Texas incentive program?

A. As a purchaser of commercial mowing equipment, you or the participating mower dealer must complete an incentive application for each propane mower purchased or converted. **Pre-qualification is highly encouraged.**

You will be required to provide data to the Council on mower usage prior to incentive and 6 months to a year after you receive the incentive.

Q. How much am I eligible to apply for?

A. ProCOT will cover **\$1,000** per qualifying propane mower with a **perpetual cap of \$7,000** per qualifying entity. Applicants must list funding from other sources like from ProCOT's national counterpart, the Propane Education & Research (PERC). Funding from other sources will be applied to incremental cost before the rebate amount is determined.

Q. How long do I have to submit my incentive application?

A. You have **60 days** from the time of a conversion and/or factory direct purchase to submit your application.

Q. After I submit my incentive application, how long will it take to receive a check?

A. If you have submitted a correctly completed application, it will take less than 30 days to process. Incomplete applications will not be processed and will delay the process until all information is provided.

Q. Where can I find the engine emissions family id number requested on the forms?

A. The engine emission's family id number is a twelve digit letter and number combination found on the manufacturer's sticker on the mower or on the engine. It will always start with a letter signifying the year of the engine (For example: GKAXS.8522EM). This is not to be confused with the FX number also known as the engine serial number.



Q. How can I find the engine serial number?

A. The engine serial number will start with an FX and is often found on the invoice from your mower dealer.
